Tenant 30 Day Notice to Vacate & Right to Request an Initial Inspection

Please be advised that you have the legal right to request an initial inspection of the above premises as relates to its condition and your security deposit. You have the right to be present during the inspection. You may decline the inspection by checking the appropriate box below.

By signing below, you are requesting that Place Property Management make an initial inspection of the premises at a reasonable time, but no earlier than two weeks before the estimated termination of your tenancy based on the notice or end of the lease. The purpose of this inspection is to allow you the opportunity to correct any deficiencies in the premises to avoid deductions from your security deposit. Any repairs or cleaning must be done in a workmanlike fashion. You may not make repairs or remodels to the unit which are prohibited by the lease.

After the initial inspection, the owner or Place Property Management will provide you with an itemized statement specifying the repairs or cleaning that would be the basis for any deductions from the security deposit. This will not be a final accounting of the deductions from the security deposit. You may make the corrections which are not prohibited by the rental agreement or by law during the period following the inspection through the termination of tenancy in order to avoid deductions from the security deposit. You have the right to be present during the inspection; however, the inspection may take place in your absence with your consent.

No later than three weeks (21 days) after the owner or agent had obtained legal possession of the premises, you will be provided with an itemized disposition of the security deposit, indicating the basis for, and the amount of any security received and disposition of the security and the owner or agent will return any remaining portion of the security deposit to you.

State law permits former tenants to reclaim abandoned personal property left at the former address of the tenant, subject to certain conditions. You may or may not be able to reclaim property without incurring additional costs, depending on the cost of storing your property and the length of time before it was reclaimed. In general, these costs will be lower the sooner you contact your former landlord after being notified that the property belonging to you was left behind after you moved out.
